Winning the Game

When there are no more face down cards on the table, each player counts the number of matching pairs of Picture Cards that he/she has. The player with the most matches wins!

BINGO GAME

Setup

Give each player a Bingo Card and put all the Bingo Chips in the middle of the table so all players can easily reach them. Mix up the Picture Cards and put them face down in a pile.

Object of the Game

Be the first player to cover three spaces in a line and yell “Bingo.”

How to Play

To start, each player takes one Bingo Chip and covers The Very Hungry Caterpillar space in the middle of his/her Bingo Card. Then, the youngest player goes first by taking the top Picture Card and showing it to all players. If a player has a square on his/her Bingo Card that matches the character and the background shown on the Picture Card, that player takes a Bingo Chip and covers up that square. Play continues to the left, with each player taking the top Picture Card and showing it to all players.

Winning the Game

When one player has covered three spaces in a line, he/she yells “Bingo” and shows the other players his/her card. If the covered spaces match Picture Cards that have been drawn, that player wins.

Players can win by getting a Bingo running horizontally (side-to-side), vertically (up-and-down) or diagonally. For a longer game, have players play until one person gets two Bingos.

MEMORY GAME

Setup

Mix up all the Picture Cards and place them face down in five rows of six cards each in the middle of the table. Set aside the Bingo Cards and Bingo Chips. You will not need them for this game.

Object of the Game

Be the player with the most matching pairs of Picture Cards.

How to Play

The youngest player goes first by flipping two Picture Cards face up. If the two cards show the same character, the player takes both of the cards and puts them next to him/her. If the cards do not match, the player flips both cards face down again, and play
