

20 Questions®

Instructions:

20 Questions can be played with two or more people. The object is to be the first to correctly identify well-known people, places and things through clues. Select a Reader, who writes numbers 1-20 on a piece of paper. The Reader then selects a card and identifies if the topic is a Person, Place or Thing. The Player on the Reader's left chooses a number between 1 and 20. The Reader crosses out that number and reads that clue. The Player has 10 seconds to guess the answer. Players may only guess on their turn. If the Player is correct, he/she gets to keep the card. If the Player is incorrect, play continues to the left, and the next Player chooses a number. If no one is able to guess the answer after all 20 clues are given, the Reader keeps the card.

How to Win:

The first player to collect 5 cards wins the game.
